



# Ross Shep T-birds Co-ed Indoor Soccer

(Anticipated Costs and Fees)



Ross Sheppard School pays for:

- the registration costs for the team.
- the cost of referees
- the cost of for field rental for all scheduled games
- the cost of field rental for all play-off and final games
- provides a medical kit and equipment required by the team
- provides gym space for the second practice each week.
- provides two coaches and 1 teacher sponsor

Students have to cost share:

- Field Rental for practices 16 times @\$79 = \$1106
- Jersey 20 @ \$22.50 = \$450
- Shorts 20 @ \$21.00 = \$420
- Socks 20 @ \$8.25 = \$165

(Silk Screening)

- Name 20 @ \$7 = \$140
- Logo 20@ \$4.50 = \$90
- Number 20 @ \$4.50 = \$90

= \$2321

If we divide it by 20, it comes out to \$120 a player. (Students will keep the jerseys, shorts and socks).

We would prefer to be paid by CHEQUE payable to “Ross Sheppard High School” with the student’s name and “Indoor Soccer” printed on the memo line. Receipts will be written up later and distributed for your Income Tax Refund.

My question is does the school cover any of it and can the school subsidize some of the cost per player?

In the past the players were responsible for the shirt and the school has eaten up the cost of the shorts, socks and screening. However, if the school eats up the cost of the facility then the kids can eat up the cost of the jersey, short socks, and screening.
